As lesson from Op Sindoor, Indian Air Force to focus on inducting long-range missiles

MI News Service, New Delhi: Following the extensive use of long-range stand-off weapons to target enemy military bases and assets during Operation Sindoor, the Indian Air Force (IAF) is now focusing on the induction of long-range air-to-ground, air-to-air, and surface-to-air missiles. The IAF has also asked the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) to develop extended-range variants of the Astra air-to-air missile, capable of hitting targets beyond 200 km, officials stated.

The Indian Air Force also created a global record by shooting down a surveillance aircraft at a range of over 300 km. The deployment of the S-400 system compelled the Pakistan military to operate either deep within its territory or at low altitudes to avoid detection and targeting. Officials said that in the recent operation, long-range weapons enabled the IAF to strike targets from distances of 250-450 km, effectively neutralising threats without concern for Chinese HQ-9 air defence systems. The IAF has also asked DRDO to fast-track the development of long-range air defence missile systems under Project Kusha.

Furthermore, the Indian Air Force is planning to procure at least two or more squadrons of the S-400 Triumf air defence system, depending on the capacity of the equipment manufacturer.

The IAF has submitted a detailed presentation to the government outlining its operational requirements, which include Rafale fighter jets, fifth-generation fighter aircraft, and a wide array of long-range weapon systems across multiple domains.

SC says ECI right that Aadhaar card is not conclusive proof of citizenship

MI News Service, New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Tuesday began hearing a batch of petitions challenging the Election Commission of India's (ECI) decision to conduct a Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls in poll-bound Bihar and observed that the poll panel was right in stating that the inclusion of Aadhaar card is not conclusive proof of citizenship. A bench of Justices Surya Kant and Joydipya Bagchi also remarked that the inclusion and exclusion of citizens and non-citizens from the electoral rolls falls within the remit of the ECI.

The petitions sought direction to quash the ECI's June 24 directive that requires large sections of voters in Bihar to submit proof of citizenship to remain on the electoral rolls. The petitions also raised concerns over the exclusion of widely held documents like Aadhaar and ration cards, stating that this would disproportionately affect the poor and marginalised voters, especially in rural Bihar.
